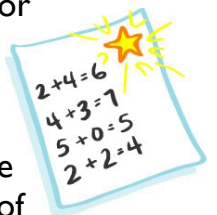

Please make every effort to ensure that your student is present during the testing days, you may check with your child's teacher for detailed information. These state-mandated assessments are one measurement by which we evaluate the learning growth and achievement of our students as well as our instructional programs. Student attendance on the testing days assists greatly with this process.

If you have a child turning age five by September 2, 2016, please contact our main office to register your child for kindergarten. Uintah Kindergarten Round-up is scheduled for Wednesday, April 20, at 2:00 p.m. We would appreciate your help in spreading the word to families that are new to our area or that will have children entering school for the first time.
