Topic

- ✓ Current Year Budget/Expenditure Review
 - Goal #1 Reading: Helping those intensive readers as identified by DIBELS decrease by 3%. DIBELS is administered to all students. Continue with PLCs including data usage. Small group reading interventions. Funding substitute teachers for PLC, and earmarking technology repairs. Down \$8,000 from this year's budget.
 - Goal #2 Mathematics: Increase proficiency by 3% by SAGE testing. One change: no measure for younger grades. Using Dreambox learning as used in the Bonneville Cone will be added into the action plan (as discussed about in January). Action Plan: PLC, district curriculum. Push for Student learning objectives. Provide math manipulatives. Grades 3-6 utilizing ALEKS program. Dreambox learning software \$1,000.
 - Goal #3 Science: Agreed to bring in STEM program. Full swing implementation by next school year. Hope is to boost science scores in SAGE. Provide PLC times. Professional development. Discovery streaming and BRAIN POP. Also adding after school programs rooted in STEM next school year. General STEM supplies \$12,862.

 - Total expenditure: Salary and emp benefits: \$26,500
 - Repairs/Maintenance: \$2,000
 - Travel: \$4,500
 - General Supplies: \$14,862
 - Software: \$5,000
 - Grand Total \$52,862 Carryover: \$5,000

 - 8 Teachers attending UMTSS Conference - \$1,500

 - \$9,000 spent on initial startup for STEM implementation
